This report sets out the proposed fees and charges for council services in 2009/10. Both the Audit Commission and government ministers have encouraged councils to look at ways of optimising income from fees and charges to help them manage pressure on resources. The proposals in this report apply an average 5% increase to fees and charges for most services although this may vary across a particular service because of rounding issues or the need to correct previous anomalies. There are some exceptions which are detailed in the report. All additional income from fees and charges is being used to re-invest in services or keep the council tax increase down.
