

A new vision for the North Circular Road

Have your say

Brent Council wants to improve the area around the North Circular Road as part of a major new regeneration project. Initial ideas for improvements to the area have been drawn up in a new vision document. The proposals seek to deal with the negative impacts of the road and highlight the many opportunities available in the area. The proposals were drawn up following feedback from small community workshops held during the summer of 2008 and from a detailed analysis of the needs and opportunities of residents and businesses in the area.

Brent Council's proposal for the North Circular Road (NCR) Regeneration Area

By regenerating the North Circular Road we hope to:

- create a series of distinct places within the regeneration area
- improve the environment for local communities with less pollution and noise, more green spaces and better community facilities
- showcase the borough's key attractions, such as Wembley National Stadium, Welsh Harp, Shri Swaminarayan Mandir, Ace Cafe and IKEA
- reduce negative impacts of the North Circular Road on local residents and turn the Brent section into the greenest stretch of road in London.

Our key objectives

Objective 1: improve the quality of the physical environment along the length of the North Circular Road.

Opportunity sites include:

- Unisys/Bridge Park: Redevelop the site to provide a new community sports facility, to replace the existing Bridge Park, and provide a mixed use development with residential, office and hotel uses
- Northfields Industrial Site: Northfields is mainly an employment site and future development proposals will need to maximise employment opportunities. There may be a possibility of having some additional residential space that makes use of the canal side location
- Brentfield/St. Raphael's Estate: Improve the feel of the area by creating new community spaces to meet in, and increase the quality of open space. We also want to improve access to and from the area.

In the long term we are also considering the removal of those properties most harmfully affected by the North Circular Road. These would be replaced with a green space designed to reduce noise and air pollution.

Objective 2: Improve the quality of open space in the area and make it easier to access.

Our ideas include:

- improve local parks with better play spaces and meeting places
- establish new green spaces, including: a 'green buffer zone' running alongside the NCR and a new parkland setting for the Shri Swaminarayan Mandir
- improve pedestrian and cycle access to green spaces. This includes paths along the Grand Union Canal, Brent River Park, Wealdstone Brook and the Welsh Harp.

Objective 3: Improve public transport and provide better pedestrian paths.

Our ideas include:

- station improvements to Neasden and Stonebridge Park stations; including a new public transport interchange at Stonebridge Park to connect with the proposed Wembley-Park Royal direct bus service
- improve traffic flow and pedestrian safety at traffic junctions along on the North Circular Road, most specifically at the IKEA junction
- new, and safe, pedestrian routes to improve access to local education, health and sports facilities.


Objective 4: continue to promote economic and social regeneration in the area, ensuring that local residents experience higher quality of life.

Our ideas include:

- maximising the local employment opportunities of new development sites
- build on the neighbourhood renewal programmes with intensive local outreach programmes to identify those people who are eligible for work and who want to work. Through these programmes provide skills training and prepare people for work
- upgrading community sports, education and health facilities across the regeneration area.
