<p>Summary: Standing Order 40 provides for non-executive members to raise an issue of their choice at a meeting of Full Council at which non-executive member items are to be debated. This report will inform the Executive of the issues raised at meetings of the Council in September and November 2003. The report will also provide an update on those issues where it was agreed by Council that the Executive should be requested to give them further consideration. These were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ The Wembley Development – street cleansing and local access to new opportunities,➤ Air Pollution in Neasden – operations on Neasden Goods Yard, enforcement of planning controls and other environmental considerations,➤ Anti Social Behaviour – assessment of ASBOs and how other actions might tackle the problem of anti social behaviour.	
<p>Nature of Decision to be taken/Intended Outcome</p> <p>The Executive will be asked to note the decisions taken at the September and November 2003 meetings of Full Council in response to the non-executive members items raised and in turn inform Council of actions taken on those items that were referred to the Executive for further consideration.</p> <p>Additional information</p> <p>At a recent meeting of the Constitutional Monitoring Group there was discussion on the method by which the Executive should respond to the issues raised by non-executive members under Standing Order 40 and how they should then be tracked. This will be subject to further consideration with a view to agreeing a process. In the meantime this is the second of such reports which ensure that all the items referred to the Executive do receive a response from the Executive.</p>
