EAL0044-03/04	DETERMINATION OF COMMUNITY SCHOOL ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS – SEPTEMBER 2005
<p>Summary: The School Standards and Framework Act 1998, as amended by the Education Act 2002, requires the LEA to annually consult upon and set admissions arrangements for the Community Schools in the borough. There are 4 nursery, 23 primary and 1 secondary Community school in Brent.</p> <p>Admissions arrangements outline the numbers of places available at a school; the timescale and mechanism for applying for one of these places; and also the criteria by which decisions on admission will be made when there are more applications for a school than places available.</p> <p>Consultation has been carried out on proposed arrangements, which were agreed at the Executive Meeting of 9 February 2004. There have been no responses to this consultation and this report asks members to formally adopt the proposed admissions arrangements.</p>	
<p>Nature of Decision to be taken/Intended Outcome</p> <p>The Executive will be asked to formally determine the admissions arrangements for Community Schools for September 2005, as outlined in the report and as proposed by the Executive Meeting of 9 February 2004.</p>	
<p>Timescale for decision:</p> <p>26th April 2004</p>
