	Air Quality Action Plan
<b>Summary</b> : In April 2001, Air Quality Management Areas (AQMAs) were declared in BRENT. This required a review of air quality to ensure that we were correct in declaring the AQMAs.	
Stage 4 review and assessment confirmed that we were correct in declaring the AQMAs, which then required us to produce an action plan to help towards achieving the air quality objectives.	
Department of Environment Food and Rural Affairs (DEFRA) and the Greater London Authority (GLA) as well as other statutory bodies were consulted on the draft Action Plan.	
In response, DEFRA required further clarification and work on the 63 actions put forward. This work has been completed and a further report has been forwarded to DEFRA. The report will provide details of actions proposed, their effectiveness in bringing about air quality improvements and their cost effectiveness.	
We are waiting for their comments before putting forward the report to the Executive.
