<p data-bbox="240 786 395 819"><b>Summary:</b></p> <p data-bbox="240 860 1356 1037">Willesden Sports Centre is due to close this summer (exact date subject to conclusion of on-going contract negotiations) as it is being redeveloped under the governments PFI initiative. The demolition and rebuild period is approximately 18 months with the new sports centre due to open late 2005/ early 2006.</p> <p data-bbox="240 1077 1356 1149">During the 18 month closure period it will be necessary for customers and Sports Clubs to relocate to alternative sports venues.</p> <p data-bbox="240 1189 1356 1335">This report will provide Members with an overview of the planned relocation.
