Presently Connexions is provided by an independent company – Connexions London West – but due to the urgent need to restructure the Partnership Board has recommended that a confederation model be implemented as quickly as possible. Under this model Brent Council would assume financial and legal responsibility for the Connexions service in the borough. The new model will ensure a tax efficient structure and be in line with proposals for the Connexions service set out in the Children Bill. This report seeks agreement to the introduction of a confederation model of operation for the Connexions Service in Brent.
