S In view of findings from recent consultation and the outcome of Best Value inspections of the Council's Parks and Cultural Services, it was timely to comprehensively revise the Parks Strategy for Brent.	
The revised Park Strategy identifies key issues affecting the use and management of parks and open spaces in the borough. It also identifies the various partners involved in the provision of improvement opportunities for parks and proposes an Action Plan for implementation.	
This revised Strategy is for the development of parks and open spaces in Brent over the next five years and is not a strategy for the Council's Parks Service, although clearly it provides a framework which will inform the future work of the service. The Strategy also sets out an action plan for delivering improvements to the borough's allotments.
