#### North West London NHS Hospitals Trust Financial Position

#### **Infection Prevention and Control**

The report focuses on the incidence and trends of MRSA and Clostridium Difficile over the past year and key actions in place to prevent these infections, progress made on infection control, and key work streams identified for 2008/09.

#### Independent Review of Maternity Services at Northwick Park Hospital

The independent review of maternity services at Northwick Park Hospital was commissioned following three maternal deaths and two serious untoward incidents in 2007/08. The terms of reference for the review included a full analysis of each of the cases, as well as a review of risk management and governance arrangements in the maternity unit. This was to ensure systems remained fit for purpose and provided assurance to the public that the maternity unit working practices and environment were safe for women. The review report and action plan developed by the North West London NHS Hospitals Trust in response to the findings and recommendations are attached at the appendix to the report.

#### **Healthcare Commission Annual Health Check Results**

The North West London NHS Hospitals Trust has received the result of its Healthcare Commission Annual Health Check for 2007/08, attached as an appendix to this report. The trust has been assessed as "fair" for quality of services and "weak" for use of resources. Therefore, under the terms of the NHS London performance regime relating to finance, the trust is classed as underperforming.





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
