PERFORMANCE OF PARKING ENFORCEMENT CONTRACT

1.0. SUMMARY

1.1. This report considers the performance of the Parking Enforcement Contract from 1st January 2003 to 31st March 2003.

2.0. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

2.1 That Committee notes the contents of the report.

3.0. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 During the financial year 2002/2003 there was a surplus of £1,865,100 of income over expenditure. This surplus was transferred to the Transportation Unit.

4.0. STAFFING IMPLICATIONS

4.1. The Parking Enforcement service is managed by StreetCare, and is undertaken by external contractors Vinci Park and Vertex. There are no staffing implications as a result of this report.

5.0 ENVIRONMENTAL IMPLICATIONS

5.1. Enforcement of the parking regulations improves the general environment.

6.0 **LEGAL IMPLICATIONS**

- 6.1 The Council has power to impose parking restrictions and enforce them under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 6.2 The power to enforce the use of Bus Only Lanes is contained in the London Local Authorities Act 1996
- 6.3 Section 55 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 lays down how a local authority must account for their income and expenditure and how deficits

and surpluses must be accounted for on their parking account. Surpluses can only be used for purposes specified by the act, such as meeting all or part of the cost of provision and maintenance of off-street parking.

Parking Enforcement (General)

- 7.1. The total number of pcn's paid and the total number cancelled above, relates to the payments currently received and cancellations currently made. As cases progress the number of cases paid and cancelled increases monthly.
- 7.2 Appendix A contains a list of pcn's issued in each controlled parking zone, the offences for which the notices were issued, reasons for cancellation of pcn's a breakdown of the top 10 locations for removals. Appendix 'B' shows all locations where more than 50 PCN's were issued.

7.3 The total amount of monies received for the period is £1,127,576 The payment rates, based on penalty charge notices paid, were as follows: -

7.4 The Bailiffs are continuing to recover debts as soon as practicable after warrants have been issued by the County Court.

Assaults on Parking Attendants

7.5 During this quarter there have been 4 assaults on a parking attendant. Details as follows: -

7.10 In the last period there were six minor assaults.

Parking Shops

7.11 The parking shop at Chamberlayne Road dealt with 83% of the Borough permit applications during this quarter, whilst the shop at Pyramid House has dealt with 17% of the applications. In the previous quarter the ratio of permit issue by the parking shops was 88% at Chamberlayne Road and 12% at Pyramid House. Permits renewed by post are now being processed at Pyramid House. A breakdown is shown in appendix 'A' of permits issued by zone and of the type of permits issued.

Bus Route Enforcement

7.12 On the 4th February 2002 Brent started patrolling two major bus routes in the Borough; routes 18 and 32. See appendix 'B' for a breakdown of pcn's issued by parking attendants deployed on each route.
