Proposed Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ): Zone SH Extension to Maybank Avenue Windmore Close and Greenbank Avenue - Consultation Letter

You may recall that you were consulted in Nov 2002 on whether you wished to be included in the proposed CPZ for your area as shown on the plan overleaf. The outcome of the consultation was that the majority of residents from Maybank Avenue and Greenbank Avenue did not support a CPZ scheme to their streets at that time.

However, since the introduction of parking Controls around the Sudbury Hill Station area, Council officers and local Councillors received a number of complaints and petitions from residents regarding parking related problems. Furthermore, Ealing Council also intend to introduce a CPZ scheme to Streets that fall within their boundary and on the other side of the Rise. Brent Council has therefore agreed with the petitioners to re-consult you on giving consideration for introducing an extension to the existing CPZ – Zone SH, as shown on the map overleaf.

As a resident / business of the area from which the complaints have been received, you are requested to indicate on the attached questionnaire, whether you now wish for your street to be included in an extension of the CPZ zone SH scheme. Please therefore complete and return the questionnaire by **Monday 14 March 2005**, using the pre-paid postage provided.

Brief details of how CPZ's operate generally are provided overleaf. A draft design of the parking arrangements for your street has been prepared and which will be on display at the *Barham Park Library, Harrow Road, HAO 2HB* from Monday 21 February 05 until Monday 14 March 05 and at the LNER Club (located between 134 Maybank Avenue and the railway bridge), Maybank Avenue, HAO 2TQ.

Council officers will be in attendance in "LNER Club" on the following days to discuss the proposals and answer any questions you may have:



HOW THE CPZ WORKS:

- All the kerbside space will be controlled. Yellow lines will be introduced to control road junctions (double yellows) and vehicular accesses (single yellows).
- Parking will be either for permit holder or in 'pay & display' bays. Residents will need to
 purchase permits if they, or their visitors, wish to park in the designated bays during the
 scheme's operational hours.
- Blue badge holders may park their vehicle without payment and without time limit in a
 permit holders bays, provided that a valid disabled person's badge is displayed.
- The cost of permits is £50 a year for the 1st permit, £75 for the 2nd and £100 for the 3rd. Each household will be restricted to a maximum of 3 permits. Visitors' Permits (vouchers) have to be purchased in advance and will be available in books of 10 at a cost of £5 per book (50 pence per voucher). Each voucher permits parking for a whole day. Alternatively, those residents who receive regular visitors, such as on a daily basis, may wish to purchase an Annual Visitor Permit at a cost of £75.
- Business Permits will cost £300 a year or, in the case of a liveried vehicle, £180 a year. A
 maximum of 3 permits will be made available for each business.
- Pay & Display' parking will be up to 2 4 hours maximum stay, and the cost of parking in these bays will be 30 pence for 20 minutes up to £4.00 for 4 hours.
- The CPZ is intended to give the permit holders priority use of the parking spaces during
 the scheme operational times, but does not necessarily guarantee a parking space.
 Experience with CPZ's introduced elsewhere within the borough has shown that residents
 are generally able to park close to their homes, even where there is a high density of
 residents.
- Zone SH Permit Holders will be entitled to park in any street within their zone, but not in
 any other zone. Similarly, permit holders from other zones will not be entitled to park in
 zone SH. The zoning helps to manage the local demand for parking, especially in the
 roads close to shopping and Station areas.

Proposed Controlled Parking Zone W (CPZ) Extension - Consultation

You may recall submitting a petition to Brent Council on June 2004 regarding parking difficulties you are experiencing in your street- **Hillside Avenue** and your desire to join the existing (W) Wembley Hill Area CPZ. The Highways Committee on 27th July 2004 agreed to re-consult you on CPZ proposals for your street, which would be an extension of the existing zone W.

As a resident/business of the area from which complaints have recently been received you are requested to indicate on the attached questionnaire, whether you now wish to be included in the zone W-CPZ. Please therefore complete and return the questionnaire by 28th February 2005, using the freepost facility.

Please be assured that a CPZ will only be implemented if there is majority support otherwise; the Council will not proceed. If majority support is identified the CPZ will be progressed and your street will be amalgamated with the existing Zone W which operates on Monday to Sunday, 8.00 am to 9.00 pm.

A brief reminder of how CPZs operate generally is provided below:

- All the kerbside space will be controlled. Yellow lines will be introduced
 to control road junctions (double yellows) and vehicular accesses
 (single yellows). This will prevent obstructive parking on junctions and
 across driveways. It will also improve accessibility for pedestrians, the
 disabled, emergency services and refuse collection.
- Parking will be either for permit holder or in 'pay & display' bays.
 Residents will need to purchase permits if they, or their visitors, wish to park in the designated bays during the scheme's operational hours.
- Blue Badge holders may park their vehicle without payment and without time limit in a permit holders bay provided that a valid disabled persons' badge is displayed.
- The cost of permits is £50 a year for the 1st permit, £75 for the 2nd car and, £100 for the 3rd. Each household will be restricted to a maximum of 3 permits. Annual permits for vehicles under 1100 cc is £25.
- Visitors' Permits (vouchers) have to be purchased in advance and will be available in books of 10 at a cost of £5 per book (50 pence per voucher). Each voucher permits parking for a whole day. Alternatively, those residents who receive regular visitors, such as on a daily basis, may wish to purchase an Annual Visitor Permit at a cost of £75.

- Business Permits will cost £300 a year or, in the case of a liveried vehicle, £180 a year. A maximum of 3 permits will be made available for each business.
- 'Pay & Display' parking will be between 1 to 4 hours maximum stay, and the cost of parking in these bays will be from 20 pence for 20 minutes, to £3.20 for up to 4 hours.
- The CPZ is intended to give the permit holders priority use of the parking spaces during the scheme operational times, but does not necessarily guarantee a parking space. Experience with CPZ's introduced elsewhere in the Kilburn and Willesden area has shown that residents are generally able to park close to their homes, even where there is a high density of residents.
- Zone W permit holders will be entitled to park in any street within the zone, but not in any other zone. Similarly, permit holders from other zones will not be entitled to park in Zone W. The zoning helps to manage the local demand for parking, especially in the roads close to shopping areas; a larger zone may encourage permit holders to drive and park within the zone in bays near shops or rail stations, thereby inconveniencing residents close to these amenities.




Zone GH Extension Appendix E

CONSULTATION ON REVIEW OF CPZ February 05

BACKGROUND

You will be aware that the CPZ which is in operation in your area was introduced in April 2004 following successful consultations with the local community. The scheme was implemented to:-

- · Remove commuter and long-term non-residential parking from the area,
- · Improve road safety by removing obstructive parking from junctions,
- To reduce the level traffic in the area by regulating parking on-street, and
- To attract more customers to the businesses –by allowing greater turnover of the parking spaces.

The responses received to date indicate that there is a general level of satisfaction with the CPZ. However, Brent Council made an undertaking to review the scheme after an initial period of operation to address any issues local residents and businesses may have and to seek their views on how the schemes could be improved.

Brent Council would therefore like your views on the CPZ in your area and how you feel the scheme can be improved.

REVIEW PROPOSALS

The issues which have prompted reviews of CPZs elsewhere in the borough are, for example, the CPZ operational times, insufficient permit holder or 'pay & display' bays and excessive lengths of 'yellow lines' restrictions. You may wish to comment on these or any other issues which are of concern to you.

A brief questionnaire has been prepared based on the above proposals for you to complete and return, although please feel free to make any comments and suggestions you may wish.

This is a preliminary consultation only to seek the views of local residents and businesses, and to find any area of common concern. A further consultation will be carried out on more specific issues before changes are made to the existing schemes.

Once again, please note the details provided above and the attached questionnaire is based on responses we have received to date.



The Dell, The Chine, Elton Avenue and The Croft

You may recall that in February/March 2004 Brent Council carried out a review of the existing controlled parking zone ST. From the consultation, the results showed the majority of the residents of the zone were in favour of reducing the current operational hours from 8am to 6:30pm Monday - Saturday to become 10am - 3pm Monday to Friday. This scheme was due to be implemented in February 2005. Following a petition in January 2005 from the residents of The Dell, The Chine, Elton Avenue and The Croft, The Highways Committee at its meeting on 27th January 2005 requested the officers to postpone the implementation of the new(shorter) operational hours.

The Petioners do not want the operational hours to be changed and want to keep the existing times. Therefore, the Council are consulting the residents of The Dell, The Chine, Elton Avenue and The Croft for their views.

If the majority of the residents from these roads want to keep the current operational hours, then a separate Zone will be created for these roads mentioned above. The remaining area of the ST Zone operational hours will be changed to 10am - 3pm Monday to Friday.

The disadvantage of creating a new zone is that the residents of the new zone permit holders would not be able to park in Zone ST, and visa-versa




