

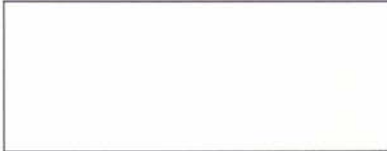

Proposed Controlled Parking Zone GS – Consultation

You may recall that in June 2002, Brent Council consulted you on proposals for a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) for your area. The consultation results showed that the majority of residents from your streets did not support the proposals and accordingly, the Council's Highways Committee resolved not to proceed with a scheme in your area.

However, since the introduction of the GH Zone, the Council have received a number of complaints and petitions from residents regarding parking difficulties, traffic congestion and general road safety. The Highways Committee has therefore agreed to re-consult you on CPZ proposals, within the area shown on the map enclosed.

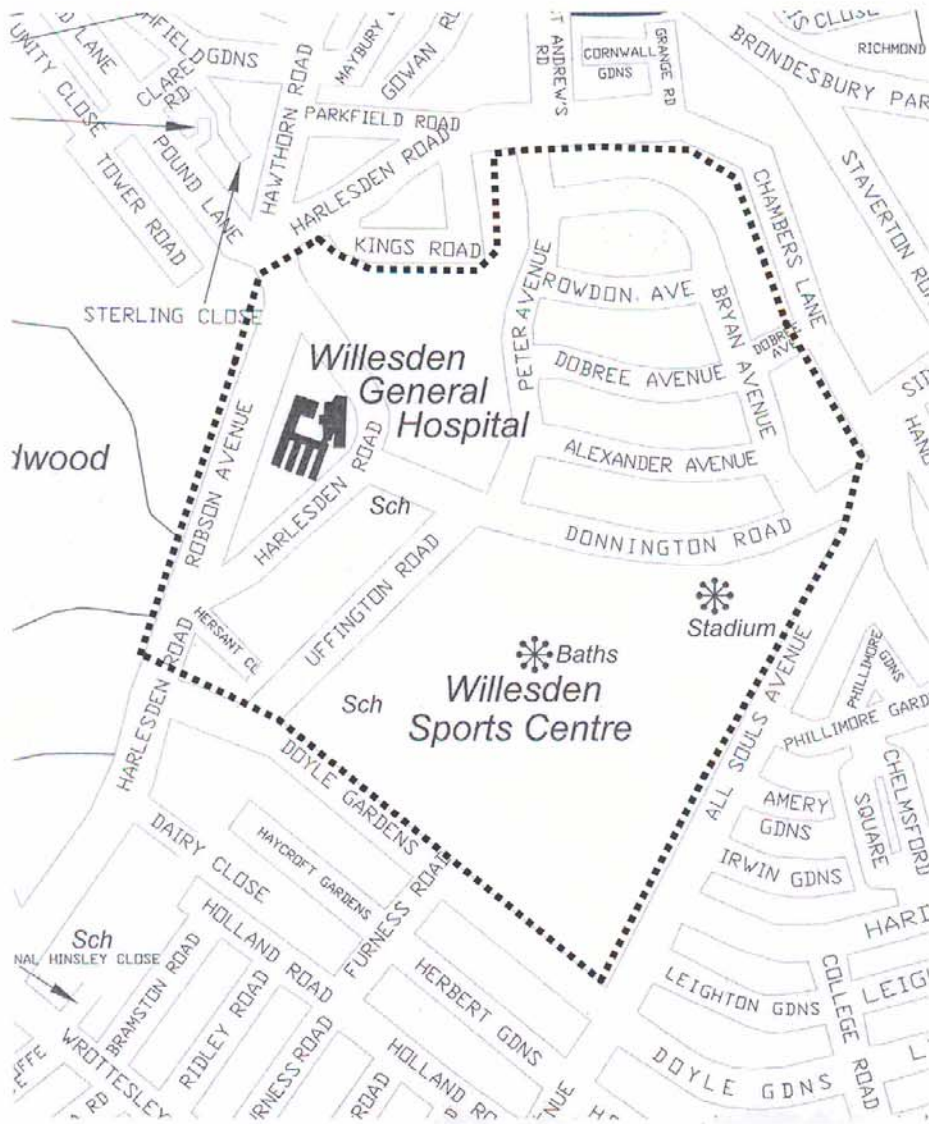

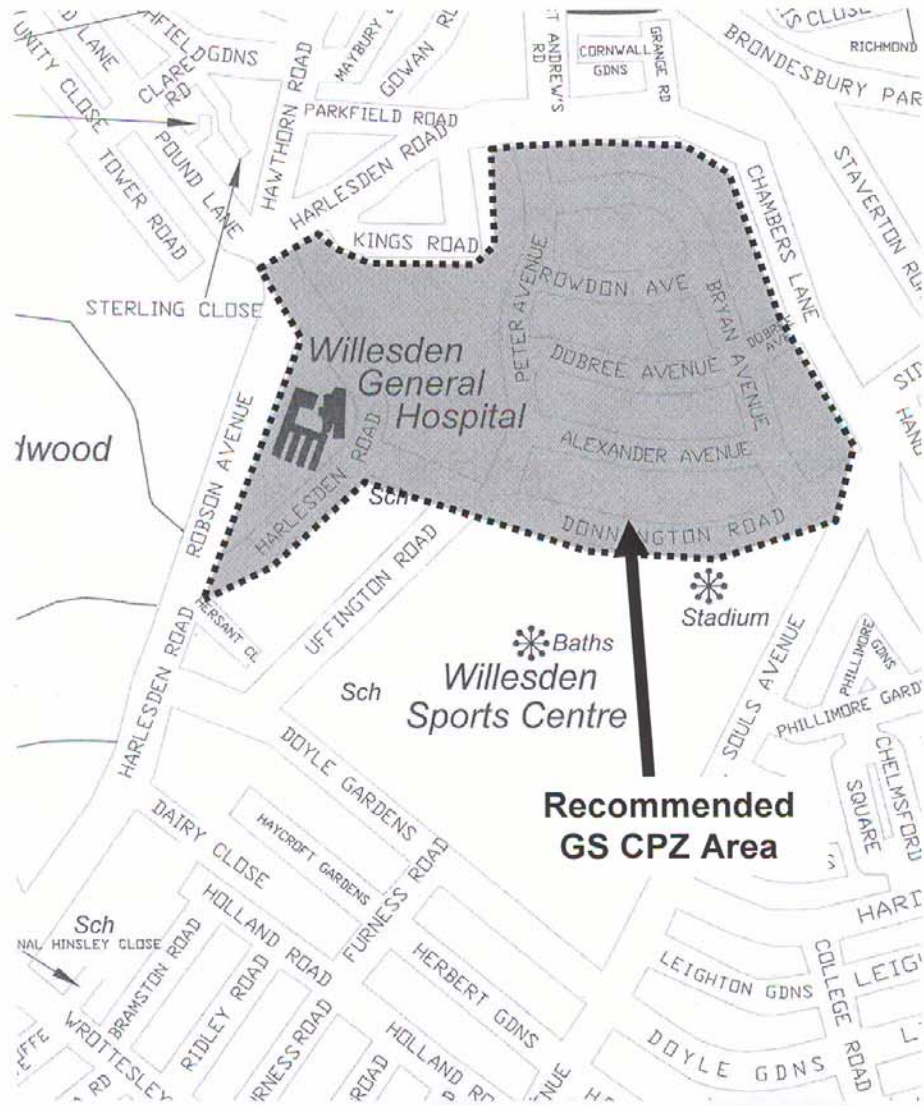
