Best Value Performance Indicators A Comparison of Brent's Performance 2005 - 2006

1.0 Summary

It is a statutory requirement that all council's must be measured and audited on their performance each year. This is done through the annual Performance Plan which is published in June each year.

Between August and November an audit process takes place and the following January the Audit Commission releases the results. This document provides detailed information on these results for the data set of Best Value performance indicators for the year 2004/05.
