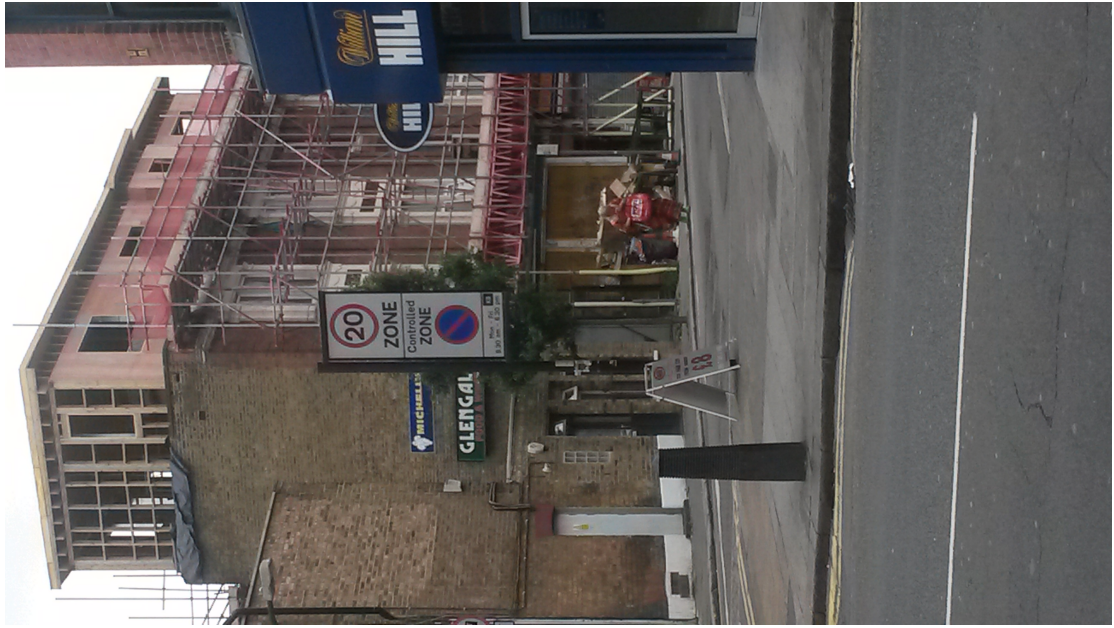
## **Members' Deliberation**
