I am a Police Constable of 12 years experience, all of which I have worked on the London Borough of Brent, I am currently attached to the licensing unit for the Borough, I have been authorised via a delegated authority to represent the Borough Commander of the London Borough of Brent and for the Commissioner of the Metropolitan Police Service to act on Licensing matters.

On the 17/03/2017 I was on duty in company with PC Whitcomb and PC McDonald at about 2315 hours we attended Greene's bar 362-364 Neasden Lane North, London, NW10 0BT.

On arrival I could see that the front door was closed, and I looked in the window where I could see that the main bar was very busy and people were still being served at the bar, I could hear music coming from inside the venue, I then looked in the window of the side bar where the pool table is situated and again could people inside, at this point Mr Tim Sheahan walked from the direction of the North Circular with a female I know to be Leigh who works in Greene's bar, I asked Mr Sheahan why the pub was still serving alcohol and playing music, he just shrugged his shoulders, I could see he was unsteady on his feet and his eyes were watery, he appeared drunk, I asked him if he had a key to get into the pub as the front door was locked, he did not reply, the door was eventually opened and Leigh went inside and started to ask people to leave.

On the 18/03/2017 I attended Brent Council CCTV room and viewed camera 32 which is situated on the North Circular and Neasden Lane North and covers the front of Greene's pub.

On viewing footage dated 17/03/2017 I could see people entering and leaving the premises until the early hours of the next morning, there were several fights with people being knocked to the floor, and large crowds gathering outside the venue.

It then appears that someone empties the contents of a bedroom above the premises onto the pavement below, the rooms above the pub are owned by Mr Sheahan, you then see Mr Sheahan and his partner coming and picking up all the contents that had been thrown onto the pavement. I exhibit this CCTV as MJS/09

It appears even with the threat of his premise licence being revoked that Mr Sheahan has no regard for the licensing objectives, or show that he is willing to change his ways.

Actions to be implemented:

The following actions are to be adhered to on a daily basis unless a detailed TEN has been submitted to police and accepted

1. Opening hours

On weekdays, other than Christmas Day, Good Friday or New Year's Eve, between **10:00** and **23:00** hours.

2. No Entry or Re-Entry

No entry or re-entry shall be permitted after **22:30 hours**

3. No open drink containers outside the premises

Customers shall not be permitted to take open drink containers **outside** the premises as shown on the plan submitted to and approved by the Licensing Authority

4. Plastic & toughened glasses

No drinks shall be served other than in plastic or toughened glasses.

5. Staff Training

Every 6 (six) months staff training on the Licensing Act 2003 and the premises operating procedures shall be provided. This training shall be documented, signed and dated. Training records shall be made available for inspection by the Police and Licensing Authority Enforcement Officers and copies shall be provided on request.

6. Door Supervisors and Security Staff to be Licensed by the SIA

Where the licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, each individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

7. Refusal book

A refusal book detailing date and time of the refused sale and the name of the person refusing the sale shall be kept and maintained and made available for inspection at the premises.

8. Incident Log

An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available for inspection on request to an authorised officer of Brent Council or the Police, which will record the following:

- (a) all crimes reported to the venue
- (b) all ejections of patrons
- (c) any complaints received
- (d) any incidents of disorder
- (e) all seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
- (f) any faults in the CCTV system or searching equipment or scanning equipment
- (g) any refusal of the sale of alcohol
- (h) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.

The period of this **voluntary** action plan will last for the next four (4) months. This action plan is **NOT** legally binding. The primary aim of the action plan is to assist you in upholding the licensing objectives and to help prevent a review of your premises licence in the future.

Earlier in the early hours at about 0500hrs the caller had seen a male throwing empty beer kegs at the public houses rear shutters while shouting incoherently he was also seen to run up onto the balcony area and knock on random flat doors.

ViW1 has again come into contact with SuS1 when he had walked to the shop to buy some milk when he has been approached by SuS1 asking ViW1 to buy two cans of beer which the caller declined.

At about 0710hrs ViW2 has seen SuS1 carrying a black bag full of empty beer bottles and a silver CCTV camera walking from the direction of the rear of the public house going to the front of the public house and has thrown the camera in the witnesses direction.

A small shovel was recovered from behind the public house in the rear access road as was the other CCTV camera being exhibited by the finding officer "'''''' 175QK

SuS1 was stopped while walking away from the rear of the public house he was under the influence of an intoxicant smelling strongly of alcohol and appearing unsteady he also had very dirty hands .
