



1. Decision

The sub-committee have listened carefully to the submissions made by all parties and the evidence provided by .

The sub-committee notes that this premises have previously been reviewed.

We have grave concerns about the management of this premises. We are satisfied on the evidence before us that, on balance, various breaches the licence conditions have taken place. It is clear that there is a problem with anti-social behaviour, connected to this premises.

The sub-committee have considered whether the imposition of further conditions onto the licence would remedy this situation. We consider that the conditions currently on the licence should be sufficient to prevent this sort of anti-social behaviour, however they are not being implemented.

Given the lack of confidence the sub-committee have in the management of the premises at present to uphold the licencing objectives, the licence will be suspended for a period of 2 months. This will give an opportunity for the licence holder to bring the management and maintenance of the premises up to the required standards.



1. Decision

The sub-committee have listened carefully to the submissions made by all parties and the evidence provided by .

The sub-committee notes that this premises have previously been reviewed.

We have grave concerns about the management of this premises. We are satisfied on the evidence before us that, on balance, various breaches the licence conditions have taken place. It is clear that there is a problem with anti-social behaviour, connected to this premises.

The sub-committee have considered whether the imposition of further conditions onto the licence would remedy this situation. We consider that the conditions currently on the licence should be sufficient to prevent this sort of anti-social behaviour, however they are not being implemented.
