FORWARD PLAN OF KEY DECISIONS

The Council is required to give **28 days'** notice of Key Decisions to be taken by the Cabinet, Cabinet Committees and council officers. Briefly, a Key Decision is defined by Regulations as a Cabinet decision which is likely to result in significant expenditure or savings, or have a significant effect on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more wards.

All Key Decisions and decisions made by the Cabinet and Cabinet Committees are subject to a call-in provision whereby a committee made up of councillors not on the Cabinet will meet to consider the decisions. Following this, the original decision maker Cabinet will take into account the recommendations of the committee and may then implement or change its decision as it sees fit. The exact date when the recommendations of the Scrutiny Committee are to be re-considered by the Cabinet or a Cabinet Committee (as the case may be) can be obtained from Democratic Services.

Members of the public are entitled to see the reports that will be relied on when the decision is taken unless they contain confidential or exempt information under the Local Government Act 1972 as amended and will be published on the council's website at least five clear working days before the date the decision is due to be taken.
