I object most strongly to this application. Firstly on practical matters there will be no toilet facilities cars will be illegally parked within RGP as happens already with the existing Romanian community centre in the park known as the Lodge. The applicants have no track record of organising such a large event in a public place and will I believe be incapable of marshalling it adequately. My house is [REDACTED] and I am already disturbed by rowdyism noise and recorded music (without the formality of a valid licence) from the Lodge. It is my belief that it is the Lodge who are the real applicants hoping to benefit commercially from this event. The use of the Church's name is an outrageous attempt by the occupiers of the Lodge who are already facing enforcement proceedings from the Planning enforcement department in respect of multiple breaches of Planning control (Tim Rolt will confirm) to confer an entirely spurious and misleading air of respectability to what would be undoubtedly a rowdy and by "promoting a Romanian ethos" (whatever that means) confrontational atmosphere possibly leading to serious public disorder.
