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



On Sunday 5th August 2012 I was on duty in plain clothes on mobile foot patrol conducting licensing visits in the Kilburn High Road area. At 1400 hours I entered Kilburn High rd NW6 7HY. As I entered the shop I saw a white male mid 30's purchasing two cans of Stella beer. I initially browsed around the shop, alcohol was on display for supply. I then introduced myself to the only member of staff working, he gave his name as Mr Shoaib Ali aged 22yrs and he was just helping Mr Ajaz Ali (the Designated premises supervisor) out while he was parking his car. He told me he dose not hold a personal licence. There was an Asian male outside selling mobile phone cards from the shop frontage. Condition 1 of the premises licence reads 'a personal licence holder shall be present on the premises and supervise the sale of the alcohol throughout the permitted hours of sale of alcohol. This condition was breached.
