On 29th May 2012 Bacovia Ltd and Mr Mihai Lupes both pleaded guilty to selling alcohol to a person under the age of 18 years. The company was fined £900 and ordered to pay a contribution to the costs of the prosecution of £487, and Mr Lupes was fined £500 and ordered to pay a contribution to the costs of the prosecution of £487.

The Court heard that On 24th August 2011 Trading Standards officers instructed two children, one girl aged 14 and a boy aged 13, to go to the defendants shop called Bacovia at 296 Neasden Lane, to attempt to buy alcohol. Both children were instructed to tell the truth if they were asked any questions and were supervised by TS officers at all times during the operation. The thirteen year old boy was able to purchase two cans of beer, a Fosters and a Becks without being asked his age, or for any form of identification to prove that he was over the age of 18.


He was served by a young boy aged 14 years old who clearly did not understand English and should have not have been serving at the till. It turned out that this was the son of the defendant Mr Lupes.

Mr Lupes was later interviewed in his capacity as Director of Bacovia Ltd and he stated,

- That he works full time at the shop but at the time in question he was away at the cash and carry.
- His son lives in Romania but was in this country for a visit.
- He confirmed that a refusals register was not being used even though it is a condition of the license.

It is clear that a child of 14 years of age should not even be in this environment when alcohol and other age restricted goods are being sold. This is nothing more that complete negligence on the part of the defendant, tacitly allowing his 14 year old son to serve alcohol. If that was not bad enough, the child cannot speak any English and so would be unable to question someone's age ,or ask for identification.
