I am employed by the London Borough of Brent as a Licensing Officer. My duties include enforcing the Licensing Act 2003. On 31st January 2012 I visited 203 Kilburn High London NW6 7HY. Mr Ali was not present. Gulnaz Hayat was present with another male who claimed to be a friend. I noted that the premises licence was not displayed. I advised Gulnaz Hayat that it was an offence not to display the licence and Mr Ali should display it as soon as possible. On March 16th 2012 another visit was carried out. On inspection the licence holder Mr Ali was not present. The shop was being run by Gulnaz Hayat who claimed to be a relation of Mr Ali. At 14:00 Gulnaz Hayat called Mr Ali on the phone and I spoke with him about not having his licence displayed. As stated on Mr Ali's licensing conditions he is to have a personal licence holder on site at all times for the sales of alcohol. To my knowledge Ms Gulnaz Hayet is not a personal licence holder and cannot supervise the sales of alcohol.
