Since being in force it has little effect on alcohol misuse in the Glengall Road NW6 and immediate vicinity. It has become a ward priority for the Kilburn Safer Neighbourhoods Team. This issue often raises it's head at local residents and Police meetings. Local businesses regularly complain to Police and stated that it affects local trade.
