I am employed by the London Borough of Brent as a Licensing Officer. My duties include enforcing the Licensing Act 2003. On May 3rd 2012 a licensing visit was carried out at 1-3 Glengall Road Kilburn NW6 7EL. On inspection the DPS Mr Javid Ahktar of 169 The Vale London NW11 8TL Personal Licence Number LN200712202 was present. I showed Mr Ahktar my ID and introduced myself. I explained to Mr Ahktar that one of the conditions on his licence was that no alcohol over 5.5% was to be on sale. I asked Mr Ahktar if it was ok to look around and inspect the fridge and the shelf where the alcohol was stocked. On the shelf there was one range of alcohol over 5.5% (Zywiec 5.6%). I reminded Mr Ahktar of the conditions on his licence that he is not to sell high strength beer. On 12th June 2012 at 16:18 a revisit was carried out due to the findings on my last visit in May. On entering the shop, Mr Jarvid Ahktar was present behind the meat counter. I introduced myself as a licensing inspector. I recalled my last visit to Ahktar and explained that I was here to check that there was no alcohol over 5.5% displayed. When inspecting the shelf, the beer called Tyskie was present. this beer was labelled 5.6% . I explained that this should not be on the shelf. Mr Ahktar should already be aware that this is not to be present on the shelf as he was told on my last visit and it is stated in the premises licence. Mr Ahktar removed the cans off the shop floor. I advised Mr Ahktar that there will be a possible review of his licence. Signed *L Miller-Johnson*
