



Anti Social Behaviour Act 2003 Part 4 Authority to Exercise Powers to Disperse Groups and Remove Persons Under 16 to their Place of Residence

The CPS Guidance should be followed by MPS Officers when applying for an Order

The relevant Superintendent must complete a section 9 statement producing the Form 118B as an exhibit.

The OIC should deliver copies of the relevant Authorisation documents (118B and section 9 statements from the Superintendent, the Local Authority representative and a local officer re publicity) to the relevant local Magistrates' Court.

Part A - Authority To Exercise Powers to Disperse Groups and Remove Persons Under 16 to Their Place of Residence

In accordance with Part 4 Section 30 of the Anti Social behaviour Act 2003, I hereby authorise constables in uniform and Police Community Support Officers in uniform to exercise the powers conferred under that section as follows:

1. Period (6 months maximum)

The powers may be exercised for the following period (not exceeding 6 Months):

To (time) 1200 hrs (24 hour clock) ON (date) 13th FEBRUARY (year) 2012 2013

Dyne Rd from J/W Kilburn High Rd to Winchester Ave, along to Salisbury Rd. Salisbury Rd along to Brondesbury Rd. Brondesbury Rd along to Brondesbury Villas. From Brondesbury Villas along to Cathedral Walk, along to Oxford Rd. From Oxford Rd along to Kilburn High Rd. From both sides of Kilburn High Rd (QK & EK) along to J/W Dyne Rd. This also includes any roads, open areas, communal spaces and car parks within the mapped area outlined in Red.

3. Grounds for granting authority

I have reasonable grounds to believe:

- a) that members of the public have been intimidated, harassed, alarmed or distressed as a result of the presence or behaviour of groups of two or more persons in a public place, and
- b) that anti-social behaviour is a significant and persistent problem in the relevant locality

The grounds for my belief as to (a) and (b) are as follows:
