Annexe 1 - Mandatory Conditions

- (a) No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when no designated premises supervisor has been specified in the licence or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his or her licence has been suspended.
- (b) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- (c) All persons present on the premises who are required to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority. No Admission of children must be restricted according to film classification.

- 3. A refusal book shall be kept and maintained.
