### Annexe 1 - Mandatory Conditions

(a) No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when no designated premises supervisor has been specified in the licence or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his or her licence has been suspended.

(b) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

All persons present on the premises who are required to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

### Annexe 3 - Conditions Attached After a Hearing by the Licensing Authority

1 CCTV shall be installed and maintained in a working condition.

2 All CCTV recordings shall be kept for 31 days and shall be made available to police and licensing officers if requested.

3 Door supervisors of a sufficient number and gender mix, shall be employed from 19:00 hours daily.

4 A summary of the Premises Licence will be displayed at each public entrance to the premises.

5 Customers shall not be permitted to take open glass containers outside the premises as defined on the plan submitted to and approved by the Licensing Authority.

6 A personal licence holder fluent in English shall be present on the premises and supervise the sale of alcohol throughout the permitted hours for the sale of alcohol.

7 Substantial food and non-intoxicating beverages (including free drinking water) shall be available during the whole of licensed hours in all parts of the premises where intoxicants are provided.

8 On major event days at Wembley Stadium the following shall apply:  
Customers shall not be allowed to congregate outside the premises.  
No glass bottles shall be handed over the bar but decanted into toughened glass or plastic vessels.

9 The Licensee shall undertake a risk assessment of any significant promotion or event, using the Metropolitan Police Service Promotion/Event Risk Assessment Form (Form 696) or an equivalent and provide a copy to the Metropolitan Police and Brent Council's Licensing Unit not less than 14 days before the event is due to take place.

10 Where an event has taken place the licensee shall complete a Debrief Risk Assessment Form (Form 696A) and submit this to the Metropolitan Police and Brent Council's Licensing Unit within 3 days of the conclusion of the event.

11 a) The maximum number of persons in the premises shall not exceed 200 providing the two exit doors are outward opening and free from fastening other than push bars; or

b) The maximum number of persons in the premises shall not exceed 60 providing the outward opening exit door is maintained free from fastenings other than push bars.

12 The kitchen shall be fire separated from the licensed area by a construction that provides at least 1 hour fire separation and the associated door shall be self closing to a standard of at least half hour fire resistance.

13 The walls and ceiling linings shall be non-combustible or meet a standard of fire resistance to at least British Standard 476 : Part 7 and is classified Class 1 for surface spread of flame.

14 Upholstered seating shall comply with BS 5852, Part 2 ignition source 5 in respect of flame retardance.

15 All drapes or curtains shall comply with flammability test methods as prescribed in BS 5876 Part 2.

16 Illuminated Exit signs shall be provided and maintained above the exit doors.

17 A system of emergency lighting shall be provided and maintained within the licensed area sanitary accommodation and the staff areas.

18 Any electrical socket outlets or power supplies to be used for musical equipment or disco equipment, likely to be accessible to performers, staff or the public shall be suitably protected by providing a residual current device or devices (RCD) having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30 milliamps.

19 A suitable, accessible disabled toilet shall be provided or the proposed water closets shall be made to be accessible to disabled persons in accordance with Part M of the Building Regulations.

20 No person under eighteen shall be admitted unless accompanied by a responsible adult.

21 No person under twenty-one shall be permitted on the premises after 22:00 hours
