We refer to the above application for a personal license by Mr Memik Cagin and a premises licence for MIR Food Centre, 451-453 Kingsbury Road, Kingsbury, London, NW9 9DT.

We would like to make the strongest complaint possible against both these applications.

There are 9 shops in Kingsbury Road that sell alcohol, 3 of which are open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The Road and the community do not need another shop selling alcohol. There are too many already.

The current social unease within the local community is at a high level caused by additional Noise, vomit, litter, beer cans, being created by gangs and under age drinker hanging about And making a nuisance.

A more distributing aspect of this ALCOHOL MECCA is the suspected selling of narcotics' from Cars that deliberately target the area due to the high prevalence of youngsters boozing And loitering caused by the attraction of cheap booze.

An additional alcohol provider will add further price competition and make it even more attractive for visitors from outside the area. The local community cannot cope with the current problem. For liquor to be sold at such attractive price it is questionable as to the genuine state of the alcohol.


As inferred many of the consumers are under age from outside the area and this problem is not prevented by the shop workers whose English is virtually nonexistent and who do not therefore ask for verifying the age of the consumers.

The consequence of so many alcohol shops is a surrogate pub and club environment which occurs on the street and not in a controlled environment where Drink Licensing Laws are more restricting and controllable.

It cannot be the objective of Brent Council to create such unruly neighbourhood but the cheap, And easy access to booze for teenagers has achieved this which will be further exacerbated by yet another shop being licensed to fuel this community problem.

We therefore strongly oppose this application.

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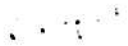



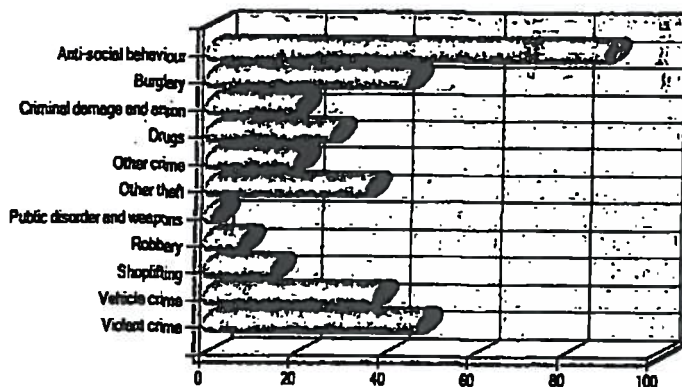

PETITION OF REGARDING PREMISE LICENSE FOR THE APPLICATION OF NEW OFF-LICENSE

Mir Food Centre of 459 Highroad Kingsbury, London, will have its fate determined at a licensing hearing. There are already more than 08 licensed premises in Kingsbury high street and 2 shops are 24hours service.

NW9 had 349 crimes recorded for January 2013. Most crime in January 2013 occurred on or near Supermarket (11 crimes), on or near Ramsey Close (10 crimes) and on or near Hay Lane (10 crimes). A detailed description of all crime in NW9 can be found below including a crime count by street/landmark. If this shop was to open until Midnight it is leading to increase Anti-social behaviour in this community.
