Dear Ms Patel

I am one of the coordinators of Odessa Palermo NW. I just read with dismay about the possible increase in numbers of people and extension of licensing hours of 'Dreams' nightclub in Harlesden. A number of residents organisations have been trying to improve the Harlesden and Kensal Green. As you know we have been working with Brent Council to achieve this aim. If this license goes ahead it will undermine all the work we have been doing and will give us the message that our work is pointless. 'Dreams' is in the vicinity of one of the worse crime hotspots in Brent. Previously when this establishment was allowed later licensing hours the anti social behaviour was so bad that the licence was altered to the current conditions. We can expect a worsening of the ASB situation if this proposal is allowed to go ahead.

We therefore object to both the increase in the number of people allowed to be on the premises and the latter opening hours in respect of:

- the prevention of crime and disorder;
- public safety;
- the prevention of public nuisance
