I certify that I have considered the application shown above and I wish to make **representations** that the likely effect of the grant of the application is detrimental to the Licensing Objectives for the reasons indicated below.

An officer of the Metropolitan Police, in whose area the premises are situated, who is authorised for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

With regard to the above application received in this office on 24th January 2014 submitted under S34 Licensing Act 2003 I would like to make the following representation.

Peaches Bar and Restaurant has been the source of crime and disorder and complaints to the Metropolitan Police Service and the London Borough of Brent since it opened in 2009 . There have been repeated instances of violent criminal behaviour resulting in serious harm. It is my opinion that the licensing objectives being breached are Crime and Disorder, Public Safety and Public Nuisance. I submitted evidence in support of an application for a review of the premises licence on 27th January 2014. I wish to rely upon that evidence in support of my objection to the above application and reserve the right to refer to it at any subsequent hearing.

The application for the review of Peaches was lodged with the Council on 27th January 2014 and served on Peaches and all other interested parties on the same date. I am happy to provide further copies of this application upon request.

A review hearing will be scheduled for the near future. I submit that the review hearing should be heard prior to any additional matter and that this application should be dealt

with after the review has been heard; either immediately following this hearing or at a later date.

I reserve the right to include any further evidence which comes to light between now and any date for a review to be heard.
