## Application for the Expedited Review a Premises Licence

### 1. Application

The application is for the expedited review of a premises licence held by Mrs Susan Diane Boyce & Mr Mark Smart. The premises are known as The Lounge, Unit 5 Unimax House, Abbey Road London NW10 7TR

### 2. Grounds for Review

The grounds for review are serious crime and serious disorder.

### 3. Relevant Representations

Representation has been received from Nick Mortimer of the Metropolitan Police.

### 4. Background

These premises are currently licensed for the sale of alcohol and regulated entertainment from 10:00 hours until 00:30 hours Monday to Wednesday, 10:00 hours until 04:30 hours from Thursday to Saturday and from 10:00 until 02:30 hours on Sunday.

The Designated Premises Supervisor is Mr Michael Ingram.

In May 2014, the licensing authority issued the licence.

Members should note that only police officers can apply for an expedited review and only where they consider the premises are associated with serious crime, serious disorder or both.

The expedited review may only be used where alcohol is sold or served.

When hearing an expedited review the Committee may take interim steps pending a full review of the licence which must take place within 28 days. The steps a Committee may take are:

- To modify, remove or add conditions
- To exclude the sale of alcohol or other licensable activity
- Remove the Designated Premises Supervisor
- Suspend the licence.
