I am giving this certificate because I am on the opinion that other procedures under the Licensing Act are inappropriate in this case because ²:

The premises was the venue of a shooting and a further GBH that occurred in the early hours of 29th June 2014.

Other procedures have been considered, temporary closures do not address the long term issues, a standard licence review could take months to reach a conclusion especially if taken to appeal and the evidence is that this premises will continue to contribute to serious assaults and disorder in the area if not closed immediately.

The expedited process is necessary to close the premises with immediate effect to prevent further crime and disorder occurring. This is deemed an appropriate and proportionate measure in view of the issue mentioned above and to prevent any further threat to public safety.
