I am giving this certificate because I am on the opinion that other procedures under the Licensing Act are inappropriate in this case because²:

The premises is a small off licence within a residential estate. The venue was visited by Police, Trading Standards and HMRC where a extremely large amount of believed counterfeit spirits and non duty paid beers. This venue is linked by husband and wife ownership with another venue that was also visited and also contained a very large amount of counterfeit spirits.

Other procedures have been considered but do not address the immediate issue of preventing the continuation of such activity. A standard review could take months to reach a conclusion especially if taken to appeal.

The expedited process is necessary to apply with immediate effect a suspension of the supply of alcohol from the licence.

This is deemed an appropriate and proportionate measure in view of the above evidence and to reduce any further offences.

Notes for guidance

- A certificate of the kind mentioned in the form must accompany the application in order for it to be valid under the terms of the Licensing Act 2003. Serious crime is defined by reference to section 81 of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000. In summary, it means:

 - conduct that amounts to one or more criminal offences for which a person who has attained the age of eighteen and has no previous convictions could reasonably be expected to be sentenced to imprisonment for a term of three years or more; or
 - conduct that amounts to one or more criminal offences and involves the use of violence, results in substantial financial gain or is conduct by a large number of persons in pursuit of a common purpose.

Serious disorder is not defined in legislation, and so bears its ordinary English meaning.
