Purpose:

The Steering Group meets on a quarterly basis to discuss and review the council's progress in ensuring effective training and development for its elected representatives.

The **terms of reference** of the Steering Group are as follows:

- 1. To be champions for, and promote, the development of members.
- 2. To keep the member Learning and Development Strategy relevant and up to date.
- 3. To review and consider training and development needs with a view to producing comprehensive induction and an ongoing training and development programme.
- 4. To take a leading role in helping the authority to achieve the Elected Member Development Charter Plus status.

The Member Learning and Development Steering Group plays a crucial role in the achievement of the Member Learning and Development strategy.

The group is member led, and includes members from three political groups. It is supported by the Head of Member Services, the Member Learning and Development Manager and the Chief Executive, who will provide guidance on learning and development.

Whilst officers are responsible for the administration of member development, the Steering Group ensures that the learning and development strategy and proposed programme of activities meets members' needs and that events are scheduled and commissioned appropriately and effectively. Any councillor may raise items for consideration at these meetings through the Member Learning and Development Manager.

The Group will meet quarterly.
