Police Objection to the Temporary Event Notice for the Wishing Well, Church Lane, NW9 on 18th March 2015.

I certify that I have considered the notice shown above and I wish to make **representations** that the use of the premises for the temporary event would undermine the crime prevention initiative, for the reasons indicated below.

An officer of the Metropolitan Police, in whose area the premises are situated, who is authorised for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

A Temporary Event Notice has been given under section 100 Licensing Act 2003 by Mr Bernard Cooney for 18th March 2015. The licensable activities applied for are provision of regulated entertainment, late night refreshment and sale of alcohol.

Police are formally making representations to the notice under section 104 Licensing Act 2003. The Police objection is primarily concerned with the crime and disorder and prevention of public nuisance objectives.

The application is for a St Patrick's Day celebration to run from 0100 to 0200 hrs.

Police request that all conditions currently attached to the premises licence be adhered to for this event. In addition a minimum of two SIA trained security officers one of each gender to ensure a safe venue. This is a residential area and this event is during the week so access and egress into the venue as well as dispersal is particularly important.

Upon agreement I will be in a position to withdraw this representation.
