Annexe 1 - Mandatory Conditions

A club premises certificate may not authorise the supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises unless it is authorised to supply alcohol to members of the club for consumption on the premises.

The supply of alcohol must be made at a time when the premises are open for the purposes of supplying alcohol, in accordance with the club premises certificate, to members of the club for consumption on the premises.

Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be supplied in a sealed container.

Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be made to a member of the club in person.

All persons present on the premises who are required to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

Annexe 2 - Conditions Consistent With the Operating Schedule

1. No noise or vibration shall be detectable at any neighbouring noise sensitive premises.
2. Functions shall be managed to ensure patrons and guests do not cause a disturbance when leaving the premises.
3. The premises shall be protected by an alarm system with links to the Police.
4. The total number of people permitted on the premises including staff and performers shall not exceed 300
5. The locks and flush latches on the exit doors and gates shall be unlocked and kept free from fastenings other than push bars and pads whilst the public are on the premises.
6. A residual current device (RCD), having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30 milliamps, shall be provided to any socket or power supplies to be used for temporary stage, band or disco equipment, likely to be accessible to performers, staff or public.
7. No music shall be played in, the car park or other external areas.
8. No form of loudspeaker or sound amplification shall be situated on or near the exterior of the premises or in or near any foyer, doorway, window or opening to the premises.
9. Signs shall be displayed in the frontage instructing patrons to recognise the residential nature of the area and conduct their behaviour accordingly. The management reserve the right to ask patrons to move inside the premises or leave if it is felt that they could be disturbing neighbours.
