I am a police officer working in the Alperton Safer Neighbourhood Team. My role title is DWO(Dedicated Ward Officer).The base I work from is situated in the heart of the Alperton Community on Mount Pleasant HA0.

Nearest junction to the base, is Heather Park Parade HA0 J/W Lyon Park Avenue which consist of numerous businesses including Jamie's News & Convenience Store, 200a, Lyon Park Avenue which is virtually next to a school. Heather Park Parade is a oblong shaped roundabout which leads onto numerous roads placing it in a central position for use by the community that live in the immediate locality and also passing public who use this route to by pass traffic to Wembley Stadium, world renowned Ace Café and the local business staff of the trading estate.

The main part of Heather Park Parade consists of a U shape parade of these shops. These businesses are constantly used by the public mainly the local residents. The area is a controlled drinking zone.

Outside Jamies News & Convenience Store, 200a, Lyon Park Avenue numerous males mainly Asians loiter outside the shop from 0900hrs to late at night involved in alcohol related disorder.

These males continue to consume large amounts of alcohol; mainly vodka and beer cans mixed with energy drinks. They litter the road; footpath with cans ,broken glass bottles, plastic cups and food containers. Fresh urination is smelt and seen on regular bases in the immediate vicinity of the shop. They show no consideration for the elderly, vulnerable and local residents going about their business. Also this route is used by parents walking their children to a school which is in the immediate vicinity.

Being the local officer I am constantly called by members of the public. This has resulted me in apprehending and

arresting these males for numerous offences which include drink related anti social behaviour and issuing of PND tickets for public order offences and threatening behaviour.

Residents who live in the immediate area regularly call up police to complain of persistent noise, crime and disorder. I go their and deal with the matter only to be called repeatedly for the same or other offences.

They group up again and carry on with their different levels of anti social behaviour related to alcohol which I witness regularly and deal with. They continue to hand out drink amongst themselves.

Despite police action and large posters and signs indicating the area to be a controlled drinking zone anti social behaviour complaints to police continue.

At times they seem to disperse when police are called and re-group when police leave and carry on with their different levels of anti social behaviour and disorderly conduct/behaviour related to alcohol which is prominent outside this shop "Jamies News & Convenience Store" growing in numbers and bringing in new members.
