PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 1 Immediate action

1. CAD 905-11FEB16 Q2 - 281QK AND 387QK, 23QK - 734QK AND 240QK, 83QK - 283QK AND 119QK

2. Officers attended the Location following reports of a Male said to have been Stabbed in the Face. Officers arrived on scene to a group of IC3 Males and Females stood at the Bus Stop, the Officers were ignored when they made efforts to identify a Viw even being told to Fuck off. However a Shopkeeper stood closeby directed the officers across the road to a male who was leaving the scene stating that he was the male with the knife.

PC 240QK ran after a male wearing a dark puffa jacket and lost sight of him on NICHOLL ROAD NW10.

As further units arrived on scene at CRAVEN PARK a loud commotion amongst the intial group at the Bus stop appeared to escalate. Upon investigation, One male was located seated on the BusStop and was bleeding from his arm, neck and abdomen. The wounds looked to be Superficial and LAS were immediately on scene to treat the male, following which he was soon placed in an ambulance and conveyed to ST MARYS HOSPITAL with PC 119QK.

Enquiries were carried out t the Scene and QK 3 attended.

Whilst at the Hospital an account from the Victim was taken and is as follows;

The Viw had been out at a friends house drinking, though he claims he didnt touch alcohol and had stuck to water throughout. At approximately 0430 hours they left the house as a group and made their way to the shops on CRAVEN PARK to buy more alcohol and drinks. Having been inside the shop to purchase a bottle of water, the male was 'confronted' by Suspect who proceeded in Punching him at least 5 times to the shoulder, neck

and head before making off in the direction of NICHOLL ROAD NW10. The Viw believes that 7
minutes later, the same Susp returned this time in possession of a knife which he used to stab the Viw 3
times to the arm, neck and abdomen. Again making off in the direction of NICHOLL ROAD NW10.

PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 2 Scene
There was a lot of confusion from those on scene as to where the incident took place on the Street. A
crime scene was instigated by officers intially but closed shortly afterward by QK3 as it offered no
evidential purpose and we could not be sure it actually took place where the scene was placed.

PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 3 Forensics
The Victims clothing has since been seized and exhibited by PC 119QK and will be booked into 66
with Ref to follow at a later date.

PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 4 Victims/Witnesses
Whilst there were plenty of People on Scene when Police arrived, all appeared intoxicated or anti
Police and refused to offer their account or Pars. One Male by the name of Omar as per the Viw Page is
said to have got inbetween the two males when the knife was brandished bu this account was only
given by the victim and not by Omar himself when spoken to at length by Police.

PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 5 Suspects
The Suspect was described by both the Victim and witnesses on scene.
An IC3 African Male wearing a Blue Puffa Jacket. He was described as being unusually Short for an
adult Male possibly F502-F504. He is said to have a Shaved head and has a Gold Tooth. Upon
circulation, Officers offered up local knowledge alledging that the description was similar to that of a
male by the name of [REDACTED].
Having viewed Custody imaging myself I was Satisfied that the male did match the description and has
previous for carrying a knife.
Officers attened the Last known address for the Suspect at approxiamtely 0610 this morning but it was
an unsuccessful attempt.

The Victim is sure that the [REDACTED] NW10 and this would indeed tie in
with the Officers footchase and the presumed Knife retrieval during the fight.

PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 6 Other evidence
CCTV has been viewed in the VIDO this morning and unfortuantely None of it is captured on camera.
Enquiries were made with the local shops open at that time but again None of it was captured.

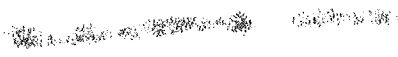

I have attended Supersave this afternoon and viewed the shops CCTV the shop has a total of 10 Cameras, two are outside the shop covering the front CCTV looking towards the bus stop shows a small crowd near the bus stop and there appears to be someone on the floor, it is difficult to make out what is happening you are unable to see if the group are male or female, or even what IC code they are.
CCTV seized and exhibited as MY01 [REDACTED] 105/1359

I have also checked the Councils CCTV Cameras, Camera 205 which is situated some distance away from the shops but is pointing in that direction again shows what looks like a group of people near the bus stop, a second camera shows a possible suspect running away, however this is very brief and there is no facial images

This has been seized and booked in book 66/ 905 105/1360

I have handed all the CCTV and statements to the OIC [REDACTED] and given her a summary of what is on the CCTV

I have also completed a statement detailing the exhibiting of the shops CCTV as the person who copied it had left by the time I had returned to seize it, and the Stick was handed to me by another member of staff.

VIW3 stated that he didn't see much and hadn't realised his friend had been stabbed, he stated that the suspect was very little and his behaviour surprised him. He stated he didn't know the suspect and had tried to intervene. I requested that he attend the police station tomorrow morning to provide a statement however he stated he has university tomorrow and cannot miss it. A statement has been arranged to be taken at 2pm tomorrow afternoon when VIW3 will attend the station.

VIW1 has been spoken to, he is well and his injuries have been stitched. He is willing to provide a further statement to police however said that police had seized his bank cards which were in his jacket pocket and he has no access to money. As such I have arranged to attend his HA tomorrow morning to obtain a further statement and will return any property in his jacket that is not required for this investigation, he also thinks his phone is in the jacket and as such cannot be contacted on it. VIW1 confirmed that he does not know the suspects name, but has seen him around before, there have never been any previous incidents between them. The suspect does not know where he lives. The victim has said that he lives with his aunt and her two children and feels perfectly safe there.

VIW2 home address was also been attended - NRRK- Note left requesting contact be made with police, contact details left.

With the above in mind the risk to the victim is deemed to be low, advice given re not attending the area where this incident occurred he is aware a suspect has not yet been arrested.

Victim - The victim has suggested that this may be a case of mistaken identity, he cannot provide any motive for this. He is currently living at an address that he feels safe in and is not known to the suspect. The risk to the victim is low providing he does not return to the area where this incident occurred which he has been advised not to do.

Suspect - The suspect is well known to police he flashes violent, weapons and drugs, there is nothing there is no intel surrounding this incident or to suggest that the risk is any different to as it usually is.
