I am giving this certificate because I am of the opinion that other procedures under the Licensing Act are inappropriate in this case because:

The premises was the venue of an affray and stabbing that occurred on 26/6/16 at approximately 1840 hrs.

This premise was reviewed by Brent Police Licensing team on 9/6/16 as a result of another assault under the Crime and Disorder objective. A standard review could take months to reach a conclusion especially if taken to appeal and the evidence is that the premises will continue to contribute to serious assaults and disorder in the area if not closed immediately.

The expedited process is necessary to close the premises with immediate effect to prevent further crime and disorder occuring. This is deemed an appropriate and proportionate measure in view of the issue mentioned above and to prevent any further threat to public safety.
