08/05/2016	Complaint of cars parking on double yellow lines, blocking end of the road, loud music, throwing rubbish out of cars.	Prioritised for Multi-agency shisha action plan visit
15/12/2016	Visit to premises as part of Multi- agency shisha action plan as a result of the above complaints.	A number of contraventions identified under the Health Act, Smokefree Regulations, Health and Safety Act, tobacco labelling regulations – for which evidence has been taken to be presented to Brent's Legal Services for further action (see photos in Appendix 1)

I would like you to take into account the above complaints and our findings of the visit of 15 Dec 2016 when considering the application for review of the premises licence. I do not feel the premises is upto the standard required by the Health and Safety at Work etc Act (unfinished, unsafe electrics, locked and/or blocked fire exits, the place is also in dis-repair, the CCTV does not cover all of the premises/exits). The person in charge of the premises is also persistently allowing shisha smoking in contravention of the smokefree regulations despite having attended a workshop in shisha cafes held by Brent Council and having received all the guidance on smokefree legislation on how to comply.










