I have obtained further Council CCTV dated 03/12/2016, again this is similar to mall the previous CCTV, it shows the pub open until the early hours of the morning with large groups of people entering, exiting and people standing outside drinking and smoking, however there are several incidents of note on this footage that I would like to bring to the attention of the committee. The first starts at 01.47 hours when a very drunk males is helped out of the pub by what appears to be a door man and sat down on a bench, the door man stays with the drunk male for about 3 minutes before going back inside the pub, leaving the male sitting on the bench, the male then gets up and staggers towards the North Circular Road, he appears to be in a very bad way swaying from side to side at 01.52 he is seen holding onto the railings and appears confused he then staggers back towards the pub, at 01.58 the camera is moved and you lose sight of the male. At 04:59 hours a male in a white T-Shirt appears to be ejected from the pub followed shortly after by a second male being ejected, at 05:01 hours Mr Sheahan comes out and appears to get in to an argument with the males, this goes on until 0505 hours.
