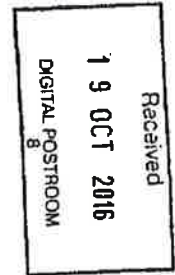



Police representation to the late Temporary Event Notice for Greenes Bar, 362-364 Neasden Lane North, London NW10 0BT.

I certify that I have considered the notice shown above and **I wish to make representations** that the use of the premises for the temporary event would undermine the crime prevention objective, for the reasons indicated below.

Officer: PC 782QK Whitcomb , Licensing Constable

An authorised officer of the Metropolitan Police Service, in whose area the premises are situated, for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

A Temporary Event Notice has been given under section 100 Licensing Act 2003 by Mr. Seamus Fogarty. The notice is for the use of the premises for a 'party' on 28th October 2016, 29th October 2016 and 30th October 2016 from 2300 until 0400 hours.

I made a telephone call to the pub and spoke with the Mr. Fogarty's licence holder and colleague, Mr. Timothy Sheehan. I asked Mr. Sheehan to explain what the party involves. The notice appears to show the event, over three days, as the same event. However, Mr. Sheehan told me that on the 28th October 2016 he has a birthday party planned. On the 29th October 2016 he has another birthday party for a different individual. Finally, on the 30th October 2016 he has a Halloween party.

I asked Mr. Sheehan whether the licensing authority were made aware that these are actually three separate events. Mr. Sheehan confirmed that they had not and that he wanted to 'save his TEN's' which is why only one TEN was submitted to the licensing authority.

These are three SEPARATE events and therefore the Licensing Act 2003 requires that these events MUST be in three separate TEN's. Further, as these are separate events at the same venue, the act requires a minimum of 24 hours between each of these separate events. (See paragraph 7.15 of the s.182 Licensing Act 2003 guidance concerning 'limitations' for more.)

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As this late TEN has been incorrectly submitted to the licensing authority, police are unable to properly assess the likely affect on the licensing objectives; therefore police ask that it is refused.
