Annexe 1 - Mandatory Conditions

- (a) No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when no designated premises supervisor has been specified in the licence or at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his or her licence has been suspended.
- (b) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

All persons present on the premises who are required to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

- (c) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
- (d) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

Annexe 2 - Conditions Consistent With the Operating Schedule

- 1 CCTV shall be installed to Home Office Guidance standards and maintained in a good working condition and recordings shall be kept for 31 days and shall be made available to police and authorised Officers from Brent Council.
- 2 A CCTV camera shall be installed to cover the entrance of the premises and the serving hatch.
- 3 No high strength beers, lagers, and ciders above 5.5% ABV shall be stocked.
- 4 A sign stating 'No proof of age, No sale' shall be displayed at the point of sale.
- 5 A refusal book detailing date and time of the refused sale and the name of the person

refusing the sale shall be kept and maintained and made available for inspection at the premises.

- 6 A suitable intruder alarm complete with panic button shall be fitted and maintained.
- 7 From 2300 hours to 0600 hours daily, entry to the shop by customers will not be permitted. All products shall be sold from the service hatch situated on the Craven Park Road side of the premises.
- 8 An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available for inspection on request to an authorised officer of Brent Council or the Police, which will record the following:
- (a) all crimes reported to the venue
- (b) all ejections of patrons
- (c) any complaints received
- (d) any incidents of disorder
- (e) all seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
- (f) any faults in the CCTV system or searching equipment or scanning equipment
- (g) any refusal of the sale of alcohol
- (h) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
- 9 The following crime prevention measures shall be implemented:

A time delay safe with deposit slot and anti fishing mechanisms must be used at the counter till area

Regular robbery awareness and cash minimisation training shall be given to all staff.

- 10 Suitable and sufficient fire fighting equipment shall be installed and properly maintained.
- 11 A 'Challenge 25' policy shall be adopted and adhered to at all times.
