few feet away from the shop front, I looked around and saw that Mr Rasitharan was tidying the fruit and Veg that was on a stand at the front of the shop, he continued to look over at us and appeared nervous, I then turned and started to walk back towards him, I took out my warrant card to show him, at which point he said 'yes I know who you are, I just realised I am sorry pleasse give me one more chance' we then went back inside the store, Mr Rasitharan kept saying 'please give me one more chance' I asked him why his alcohol was still on display for sale, and why he had sold me the can of K Cider, he said 'I was distracted as I was on the phone' I pointed out that he took the money from me and eventually placed the can into the bag for me, he replied 'yes sorry give me one more chance, I am closing the shop now' I then took some pictures of the alcohol that was on the shelves and in the fridge, I informed him that someone from Brent Police licensing will be contacting him about this and then left the shop.
