Thank you for your email.

We do not have engineers to obtain the CCTV recordings, it is the responsibility of the premise licence holder to supply this to us. Whilst the installation of CCTV and provision of CCTV recordings is not a condition on your premise licence, we would strongly suggest that you have CCTV in a good working condition and recordings are kept for 31 days in order to uphold the licensing objections. Please find attached guidance on CCTV from the home office, which I hope you find useful.

As discussed during my visit on Tuesday 27th September 2016, as the licensee and DPS, you are expected to know all the conditions on the premises licence and to have made provisions with staff to ensure that none of the licensing conditions are breached. You are also required to know the hours you are authorised for the licensable activities you have been granted by the Licensing Authority.

May I also remind you that your application for the variation of your premises licence had been rejected. As per the attached email from the licensing team on 27th September 2016, we cannot proceed with your application until you have provided all the relevant documents and amendments, which is required by **Friday 14th October 2016**.
