To whom it may concern,

I object to the alcohol licence application by **Mr. Chung Lin, FOOD 4 LESS, 38 Queensbury Station Parade, HA8 5NN.**

I have an interest in this application that is greater than the general public because it will affect the safety of myself, my wife and more important my children.

I want to object the application on the following grounds:

Objection 1: The prevention of crime and disorder

Queensbury Station Parade has already 4 off licence shops that trade alcohol and Morrisons supermarket around the corner that trades alcohol too.

Objection 2: Public Safety

Queensbury Station Parade Park is already an unsafe place due to the people consuming alcohol in public places. I do not feel safe walking around Queensbury Station after 8PM due to people causing disturbance after drinking alcohol.

Allowing another shop user to sell alcohol will make me wonder what kind of laws work in UK and what kind of people are working in Councils defending the wellbeing of its residents and working for UK's citizens.

Objection 3: Prevention of public nuisance

As I already mentioned there is already a high consumption of alcoholic drinks in the area and especially in the evenings and weekends.

Evenings are unsafe to walk around the station and I would worry even more for the women who are always disturbed by the drunkards approaching them or following them.

Objection 4: The protection of children from harm

Queensbury Station Parade is always abundant of children going to Schools or going home, maybe playing in the park and always seeing drunk people sleeping on the grass and on the alleys, always being witnesses to misbehaviours due to high consumption of alcohol.

How can we protect our children from not seeing these behaviours?

How can we educate them in this environment?

What kind of adults will our children be when they grow, while in their childhood this is what they see? Drunk people, disturbance, nuisance, swearing, fighting ..Is this what the council does for its residents?

I hope not! I want a safe place to live with my family and to be able to grow my children into decent adults.

Please work for the safety of Queensbury's residents and do not allow another alcohol licence in this area.
