It appears to me that there is a problem with drunkenness at the venue which affects peoples judgment, and leads to disorder, victims are then unable to give a proper account of what has happened, the lack of management at the venue is clear and they seem to have no dispersal policy in place, there are also concerns around the door supervisors, there are allegations of them
assaulting patrons, and of not providing the police with evidence to support an offence, it is apparent that the club has not improved from the first two reviews, and have done little to implement the conditions on the licence, or uphold the licensing objectives.
