**Licensing Representation to the Initial Application for the Premises License for
MASTER KEBAB, 20 Park Parade, London, NW10 4JG**

I certify that I have considered the application shown above and I wish to make a representation that the likely effect of the grant of the application is detrimental to the Licensing Objectives for the reasons indicated below.

An officer of the Licensing Authority, in whose area the premises are situated, who is authorised for the purposes of exercising its statutory function as a 'Responsible Authority' under the Licensing Act 2003.

The application has been made for a new premises licence under section 17 of the Act.

The Licensing Authority representations are primarily concerned with the four licensing objectives;

- the prevention of crime and disorder;
- public safety;
- the prevention of public nuisance; and
- the protection of children from harm.

The Licensing Authority require the following points to be included in the operating schedule or added as conditions on the premises licence:

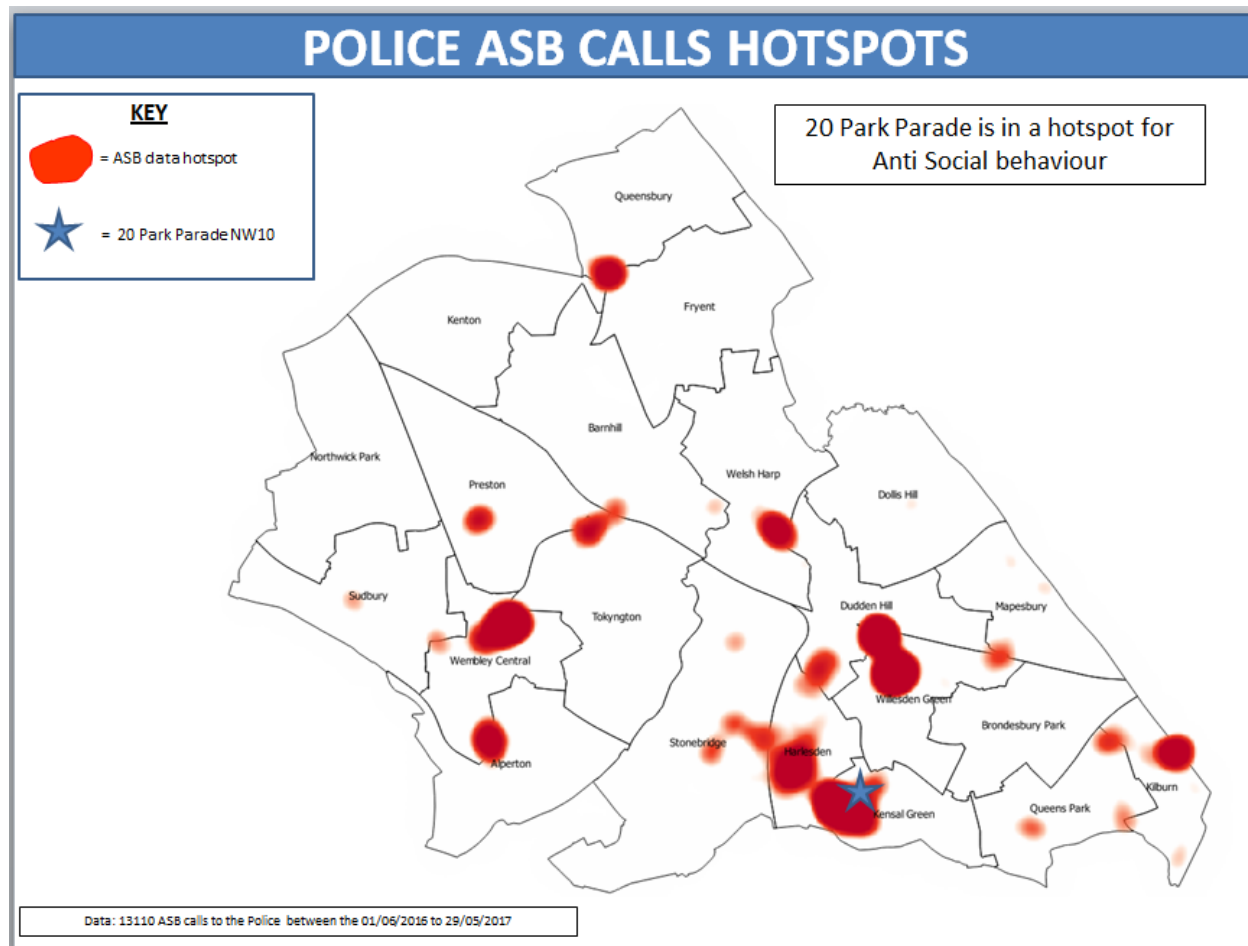
- 1) CCTV shall be installed to Home Office Guidance standards and maintained in a good working condition and recordings shall be kept for 31 days and shall be made available to police and authorised Officers from Brent Council.
- 2) A CCTV camera shall be installed to cover the entrance of the premises.
- 3) Notices asking customers to leave quietly shall be conspicuously displayed at all exits.
- 4) All deliveries shall take place during the normal working day (i.e. 09:00 to 18:00 daily)
- 5) A copy of the premises licence summary including the hours which licensable activities are permitted shall be visible from the outside of each entrance to the premises.

- 6) The licensee shall keep an incident book which shall be made available to the Police and Licensing Authority.

Trading Hours

The application request that late night refreshments to be supplied from 23:00hrs to 05:00 hrs and premise to open to the public 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Brent Council's Anti Social Behaviour analyst confirmed that the premises is located in a hotspot for Anti Social Behaviour.



In light of the fact that the premise is located in an ASB hotspot and surrounded by residential dwellings, the Licensing Authority are concerned that the proposed hours would fuel more problems in the area. Furthermore there is a club within close proximity and should the premise remain open, it would potentially attract further anti social behaviour problems from the patrons after dispersal. In order to mitigate any potential problems from the patrols of the club premise, the Licensing Authority propose the following hours.

Late Night Refreshments

Sunday to Thursday – 23:00hrs to 00:00hrs

Friday and Saturday – 23:00hrs to 02:00hrs

Opening Hours

Monday to Friday - 08:00hrs to 00:00hrs

Saturday and Sunday – 09:00 hrs to 02:00hrs

In order for the Licensing Authority to withdraw this representation, it will be necessary for you to confirm in writing that you are willing to accept the above.
