

## Members Annual Review – Cllr Reg Colwill

Following my re-election to the council in May 2010, I have completed the following activities as a councillor over the Municipal Year 2010/11.

During this year, I have been appointed to the Health Partnerships Overview & Scrutiny Committee, the Admissions Forum and have continued my work on the Standards Committee. I have also been appointed as the Vice-Chair of the Overview & Scrutiny Committee and have had the opportunity to chair meetings on several occasions. Mid-way through the year, I was appointed to the Board of the Brent Housing Partnership (BHP). I have also taken part in several meetings of the Constitutional Working Group and in two task groups on Fuel Poverty and Car Repair and Spray Painting Garages. I was also elected as the Deputy Leader of the Conservative Group in May 2010 for the first time and was re-elected again this year. In this role, I have deputised for the leader on several occasions.

I hold a surgery on the first Saturday of every month at 271 Preston Road, Wembley and I regularly meet with my constituents on a wide range of issues. I have helped residents with all manner of casework problems including planning issues, highway repairs, tree removal and cleaning up the area and I have been actively campaigning to save our local libraries from closure. I am a member of the Friends of Woodcock Park Committee and work closely with the local Northwick Park Residents Association.

I am a school governor at St Gregory's School and at BETS and undertake regular ward walkabouts with the Neighbourhood Working Team.
