I submit the following review as activities I have participated in as a councillor over the Municipal Year 2010/2011.

Local ward work:

I have found it useful knocking on doors asking what I can do for the residents from the time that I was selected. As a consequence of this I was able to help a lot of people. For example I have obtained from TfL a shelter with seats and a Countdown sign for the bus stop on the Harrow Road nearest the Elders Project. I have also been able to assist a number of people through meeting them at events, surgeries and by responding to their requests and queries by phone and email

Surgeries held: first Saturday at St Mark's in All Souls Avenue and on the fourth Saturday at All Souls in Harlesden.

Council meetings attended: I have attended all the regular council meetings and most of the meetings of the various committees that I serve on, namely Children and Young People Overview and Scrutiny, Alcohol and Entertainment Licensing Committee, Health Partnerships Overview and Scrutiny and shadowed the Executive Member for Adult Social Care. I have been in attendance at a planning meeting where the proceedings affected my ward, and have served as a substitute at One Council meetings. In addition I have served on the Fuel Poverty Task Group.

Community meetings attended: Various, including tenants and residents associations, ward panel meetings, local fora, fundraising events for community organisations and various other gatherings.

Work in respect of which a special responsibility allowance is paid: I serve on the Alcohol and Entertainment Licensing Committee. One of the hearings, about a license extension, went on so late into the night that I did not get home till 2 am the next day.

Participation in outside and governing bodies: I serve on the Willesden Consolidated Charities Board.

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Training events attended: I have attended various training events including updates on Licensing and Fostering.

Other achievements throughout the period: I have been able to help a number of people in a number of ways. For instance I received an email from a resident whose peace was regularly disturbed by filming in her street and whose disabled parking bay was often obstructed by the film crew's vehicles. The council officers were very helpful. They stopped all filming for 3 months, visited the area when filming was going on and gave the resident a mobile phone number so that she could quickly report any further obstruction.

I am pleased to have served on the informative Fuel Poverty Task Group.
