VIW1 received a stab/slash wound to the left hand side of his face from the top of his eye brow, down his cheek and to his chin.

VIW2 is a barmaid at the venue and witnessed the incident.

VIW3 works at the venue and witnessed the incident.

VIW4 lives with VIW1 and was at VIW1s home address when police arrived but he did not witness the assault.

VIW5 lives with VIW1 and was at VIW1s home address when police arrived but he did not witness the assault.

VIW6 was inside the pub but did not witness the assault. VIW6 also lives with VIW1.

VIW1 stated that he was inside the venue when suspect 1 was causing problems and he was asked to leave by VIW2 - REDACTED (NAME). Suspect 1 has become vocal and VIW1 and other people inside the venue have stopped suspect 1 from entering the venue.

VIW1 ended up outside the venue with suspect 1 and punches have then been exchanged between them. VIW1 stated that what he thought were punches were not hard and VIW1 stated did not hurt him as they were not hard. He has then seen the blood coming from his face and he has then stated that he did not want anyone seeing him bleeding so he has then left the venue and walked the short distance to his home address. *****VIW1 stated that at this time he did not want to make a statement to police but he stated that he would like police to contact him tomorrow. VIW1 had been drinking and due to his injury he needed stitches to his face which the Dr stated would be three (3) layers worth of stitches.*****

VIW2 - REDACTED (NAME) stated that she arrived at the venue at approx.

PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 1 Immediate action

1130 hours and suspect 1 was inside the venue sitting by the door. VIW2 stated that suspect 1 was not drunk and from 1130 - approx. 1415 hours she only served him a hot whisky and a pint of Guinness. VIW2 stated that suspect 1 lit a cigarette while sitting at the table and she shouted at him, "PUT THE FUCKING CIGARETTE OUT OR GO OUTSIDE WITH IT". Suspect 1 has put the cigarette out and said sorry.

Suspect 1 has then started to talk loudly about people blocking the sink in the toilets with paper. VIW2 has asked suspect 1 to respect regulars and to keep their voices down. A short time later a regular has complained again to VIW2 about suspect 1 and other males and VIW2 has asked suspect 1 to leave. Suspect 1 has put his drink onto the bar and said "VICTIMISING ME". Suspect 1 left the venue. A short time later suspect 1 has walked back into the venue and started talking to the males again who he was sitting near. A unknown Somalian male has then entered the venue and looked towards suspect 1. There were approx. 10-12 other Somalian males outside the venue. VIW2 walked out to them and asked them if they had a problem. the group replied, "NO YOUR PUB JUST STINKS. WE JUST WANT THE GUY WITH THE HAT, HES JUST SAID SOMETHING GAY TO US". VIW2 has asked the group to leave him alone as he was drunk although she did not believe this, she just said it to get the group to leave, the group have then left the venue.

VIW2 has then started to tidy up the venue and has gone out to the back of the venue for a cigarette. When she returned, she saw VIW1 and other customers in the venue trying to stop suspect 1 from entering.

PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 1 Immediate action

VIW3 who is also a barmaid has tried to separate the group and asked suspect 1 to go away. VIW1 and suspect 1 have ended up outside and VIW2 is not aware who threw the first punch but then approx. 2-3 punches have been exchanged between VIW1 and suspect 1 and VIW2 has then seen VIW1 covered in blood. VIW2 stated that she saw suspect 1 holding a "SWISS TYPE KNIFE, CHUNKY BLADE THAT FLICKED OPEN". Suspect 1 has then picked up the knife that he had dropped and walked off towards the subway in NEASDEN CIRCLE. VIW1 has then walked to his home address. ****VIW2 provided a statement to police****

VIW8 - REDACTED (NAME) works in the REDACTED (VENUE) and he states that REDACTED saw VIW1 and suspect 1 fighting outside the venue and he saw VIW1 covered in blood. REDACTED.

VIW1 was taken to Northwick Park Hospital by LAS.

SOCO requested and attended the venue. Photographs and blood swabs taken at the venue. booked into the freezer, 105/3078 and 66/8323 refers.

ND CID update- DC TRIST & PC KAPOOR attends:

Police were called to an incident where a male was stabbed in the face.

Suspect was drunk and trying to get more drinks from a pub called SAL'S BAR. When suspect was refused service he started arguing with the bar staff, victim got involved in trying to help the bar staff and was slashed in the face by the suspect.

Victim:

Victim is known as REDACTED - (DESCRIPTION)

Victim was in his local bar (SAL'S BAR) having a few drinks and tried to help the bar staff who were having troubles with the suspect.

Victim lives REDACTED. He is a regular and has never been involved in any fights before. Today, he was trying to help the bar staff when he got assaulted by the suspect. Victim managed to get home and his friend called police and LAS for help.

Victim was taken to hospital, he was accompanied by a female friend (REDACTED). Victim has refused to engage with police at this stage and has refused to provide an MG11.

Suspect:

Suspect is REDACTED. Suspect used A SWISS ARMY KNIFE to assault the victim and was seen hiding this in his sock before leaving the venue.

Suspect has been frequenting the SAL'S BAR for 3-4 weeks and always acts suspiciously and has his face hidden as he is always

seen to be wearing a cap/hat, hiding the top part of his face. Today after having the initial argument with bar staff, he kept going in and out of BAR and came back with few SOMALIAN lads from the area.

Suspect is known in the area and uses a local cab office to take a cab back to the general area of REDACTED. His exact address is unknown at this time. Suspect might have a REDCATED who works in a call centre in REDACTED.

Further enquiries conducted by CID at the REDCATED. They do not hold a contact number for the suspect on their computer systems and can not provide an exact road or address.

Venue:

Initial argument started outside the SAL'S BAR where suspect was refused service and he ended up fighting with the victim. The actual assault took place in the middle of the road or across the road near a bin (believed to be o/s NEASDEN HARDWARE Store).

There was a crime scene put in place and evidence was preserved till SOCO attended. Another crime scene was started at the venue where victim lives (see VIW1 page). victim's clothing with blood was seized by police and this scene was closed upon advice of CID.

Dog unit attended to conduct a search of the locality for a weapon- no trace.

Injuries:

Victim has received 3 slashes to his face which would leave a scar. His injuries are not deemed to be life changing or life threatening (attended NWP Hospital)

Forensics:

SOCO have attended the crime scene o/s NEASDEN HARDWARE Store and taken photographs and swabs of blood. There is no CCTV footage of the incident at present to assist in the examination any further

and no signs of any weapon discarded.

CCTV:

CCTV enquiries conducted at SAL'S BAR – picture of suspect is available. The footage does not capture the incident but it does have a clear image of the suspect. This might help in identifying the suspect. PC Finesilver is in possession of a photograph of the suspect.

Owner can access footage on his mobile phone but does not know how to download the footage.

He has requested his technician to download footage and it should be ready for collection by TUESDAY.

There is a camera O/S REDACTED. This camera might have captured the actual assault or parts of it. Shop was closed and hence no enquiries could be made with the owner/staff.

There is a camera O/S REDACTED. Shop is called REDACTED and CCTV footage can be requested via head of security REDACTED who can be contacted on REDACTED.

There is a camera O/S REDACTED located at REDACTED. Camera 5 covers footage outside the shop and footage is kept for 28 days. Can be requested via REDACTED Who can be contacted on REDACTED.
